Year 11 have continued their fine start to the academic year this week. As a year group, they have amassed close to 1000 positive points awarded with 210 students in Year 11 this week achieving at least one positive point for their work/effort in lessons, with 186 students receiving multiple positive points. Standout performers in Year 11 this week include Evalyn B, Evie B, Tegan H and Regan H, all of whom achieved at least ten positive points this week! Well done to those students.

This week also delivered a well attended 'Pathway to Glory' evening, which focussed on sharing the roadmap for the year ahead, how we will support our students in their academic progress, as well as key advice for families to be able to support students at home. In addition to this, the evening also provided an opportunity for students and parents to not only meet members of our sixth form team, but colleagues from the wider world of education including several colleges which may be of interest to our students over the next three years.

In tutor times this week there have been two revision sessions for students where they have been given the opportunity to focus on revising key areas and improving their retrieval skills.

English intervention took place afterschool on Wednesday for selected students and next week will see this expand to Maths, English, Science, History and Geography as our year long programme of study for revision really kicks in. Information regarding this was shared during the 'Pathway to Glory' evening, detailing that we will run on a two-week timetable to enable targeted intervention one week and open revision the following in each of the subject listed. This is to ensure that 100% of our students have access to multiple revision sessions throughout the half term and beyond!
